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### **Education and Training Reform Act 2006**

On 15 March 2018, Daryl Richard John Carr, a 56-year-old teacher registered in Victoria, ceased to be registered and was disqualified from teaching on the basis that he had been found guilty of a 'sexual offence' as defined in section 1.1.3 of the **Education and Training Reform Act 2006** (the Act). This decision was effective from 15 March 2018 and was made pursuant to section 2.6.29 of the Act (as in force at the time of the decision).

On 16 March 2020, the County Court of Victoria set aside the Orders made by the Magistrates' Court of Victoria and dismissed all of the criminal charges. Pursuant to section 2.6.29(5) of the Act, the cancellation of Daryl Richard John Carr's registration and his disqualification from teaching ceased to apply from 16 March 2020.

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### **Electricity Industry Act 2000**

#### NOTIFICATION OF GRANT OF LICENCE TO GENERATE AND SELL ELECTRICITY

The Essential Services Commission (the commission) gives notice under section 30(a) of the **Electricity Industry Act 2000** (Vic.)
